3rd Wednesday Singing Night at the Wheeler Care Center - 6:15 pm.



This is especially true in our spiritual lives. We may think it's easier if we never push ourselves to do more for God or to learn more about Jesus, but that is the opposite of God's desire for us. He wants us to live for Him! Remember what we read in Hebrews 5:12 about Christians refusing or just not being interested in growing spiritually?

12 In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food!

Paul says the same thing in I Corinthians 3:2:

2 I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready.

Both are heartbreaking accounts in the early church. These Christians should have been ready to spread the Word and be teachers, but instead they needed to relearn the elementary truths in God's Word and had not grown in their knowledge. They were still on square one of the Christian walk.

Don't stay on square one. Be determined to grow! You'll be better for it and will be doing exactly what God wants of you!
