This past week at Wheeler Church of Christ was Vacation Bible School week. This marks the fourth year I've been involved helping with VBS, and I have to say each year I am more and more impressed with the great job our church does with this work. More than 50 kids attended the festivities each day for the "Trailblazers for the Faith" themed event.

When you think of trailblazers what do you think of? Many might think of those hard-working pioneers moving west to begin a new life in the United States. Some might think of the basketball team out of Portland (named after these trailblazers I might add). What about trailblazers when it comes to faith?

Each day at VBS we learned of a Bible character who fit this mold. One day we studied about Jacob, and it had been a while since I thought about all Jacob went through to eventually become the pillar of faith we know him as today. In Genesis, we read of how he was quite a deceptive person. He tricked his brother into giving him his birthright, and he then tricked his uncle Laban into giving him more livestock than he was owed. Jacob quickly made lots of enemies and had nowhere to turn. While fleeing Laban with his family, we read of the famous account in chapter 32 where Jacob wrestles with God (who is appearing as a man) throughout the night. Jacob refuses to yield and demands a blessing, and God gives him one. In verse 28 God says:

²⁸Then the man said, "Your name will no longer be Jacob, but Israel,^[1] because you have struggled with God and with humans and have overcome."

Changing someone's name might not mean much to us, but it did to Jacob. His name went from meaning "Heel catcher" or "One who overthrows" to Israel meaning "One who rules" or "One who prevails with God."

God meant Israel would now be focusing on Him, and although life would still be a struggle, he would have many successes with God as His leader. The very next chapter we see a tearful reunion, not a violent one, between Israel and Esau, the brother he had wronged many years before.

What a lesson for us. If we can just focus on God and make Him number one, we too will have many successes. God doesn't guarantee our lives won't have heartache or difficult times, but we may rest assured he will take care of us and ultimately reward us with a home in heaven. ~ Jeff
