As we gather to worship this morning I'm reminded of the beginning of Psalm 98. There we read this:

¹ Sing to the LORD a new song,
for he has done marvelous things;
his right hand and his holy arm
have worked salvation for him.

² The LORD has made his salvation known

and revealed his righteousness to the nations.

³ He has remembered his love

and his faithfulness to Israel;

all the ends of the earth have seen

the salvation of our God.

This Psalm was written to praise the Lord because He freed his people from slavery, but as Christians we need to be thankful for a different type of freedom and a much more important one ... the freedom from the consequences of sin. How does that work? Well Paul writes about it in I Corinthians 6:9-11. There Paul gives a long list of those who will not inherit the Kingdom of God and follows it up by saying in verse 11:

¹¹ And that is what some of you were. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

I like the sound of that ... "Justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ." Are you "Justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ?" I hope so! If you are interested in learning more about what that means let me know. There isn't a day that goes by that I'm not thankful for what Jesus Christ did for you and I on that lonely, cruel cross at Calvary. Have you heard about his message of redemption? Do you believe it? Have you confessed Him as your Savior? Have been baptized for the forgiveness of your sins being added to the Lord's Church? Don't wait any longer. Freedom from the bondage sin is within reach! -Jeff
